

Pairing the First Time



Color Changing Rechargeable

- » Make your Bluetooth device "discoverable" » Power on speaker
- » The first time the unit is powered on it will enter auto-pairing mode.
- » Select "iHome iBT81" on your device's Bluetooth menu to complete pairing.
- » To manually pair, power on unit then press and hold Bluetooth Button for 2 sec. Select "iHome iBT81" to complete pairing.
- » Press Play/Pause Button to play and pause Bluetooth audio.
- » To clear/reset Bluetooth. press and hold Bluetooth Button for 10 sec.

COLOR CHANGING MODE

» Press the color mode button to cycle through modes

SLOW FAST ONE COLOR PULSE OFF

LED STATUS INDICATOR (TOP OF UNIT)

Solid Red = charging Flashing Red = low battery Red LED off = fully charged Flashing Blue = pairing

USING THE VOICE CONTROL FEATURE

NOTE: The unit must be powered on and linked to an iOS or Android Bluetooth device to use Voice Control. Press and hold the J Button for 2 seconds and wait for beep to activate voice control with Siri or Google Now.

Voice control requires an active internet connection on connected Bluetooth device with iOS 10 and Android 4.1 and later. When activated, the speaker microphone acts as an extension of the microphone in your smartphone to make/take calls, enable you to ask Siri*/Google Now™ to play music and more.

» If there is no audio or light mode detected after 15 minutes the unit will auto power off to save battery life
