Using Radio In Other Countries

- 1. While unit is OFF, press and hold the Mode Button for about 5 seconds until the region flashes Press the + and - Buttons as needed to set the display to your region: USA, EUROPE, JAPAN,
- Press and release the Mode Button (or no button within 10 seconds) to exit the radio frequency setting mode. Two beeps will confirm radio frequency setting.
